Because of the smaller payments during October resulting in a large deficit, and the increased amount of our work (with particular reference to the fall speakers' program now in progress), and also because of the large sum of unbudgeted expenses, you will recognize that the total now due of \$110,000 represents a sharp increase. I know that each month I urge the wiping out of the deficit by the payment of the full amount due to us. I can only repeat that, particularly in view of the fact that we have to spend monies for our program first and then seek for reimbursement thereof, it is most essential that all of this money be remitted to us during November. I know that I can count on your co-operation to do the best you can under most difficult circumstances.
