Dear Gottlieb:

Below is the accounting due on April 1, 1957, several days late because we wanted to anticipate certain items now concluded as reflected in the item "Extraordinary Unbudgeted Expenses."

I want to call your attention to the unusually high total which results from these expenses, plus the final payment due the Rabinowitz Foundation, plus the heavy load of our Speakers Program, plus the additional expenses for the Madison Square Garden Rally on February 25th, and -- this is the largest contributing factor -- the extremely large balance still due to us on April 1st. As a matter of fact, these factors which I have enumerated, account for over \$80,000, or more than 55% of the total herewith submitted.
