

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

**Whereas** Herman Greenspun was convicted in the United States District Court for the Southern District of California on an indictment (No. 21266-CD), charging violation of Section 371, Title 18, United States Code, Provisions of Presidential Proclamation No. 2717, effective February twentieth, 1947, and Provisions of Presidential Proclamation No. 2776, effective April fifteenth, 1948, and, on July seventeenth, 1950, a fine of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) was imposed; and

WHEREAS the said Herman Greenspun promptly paid the aforesaid fine; and

WHEREAS, since his conviction, the said Herman Greenspun has conducted himself in a law-abiding manner:



Now, therefore, be it known, that  
**John F. Kennedy**, President of the United States of  
 America, in consideration of the premises, divers other good  
 and sufficient reasons, has granted unto the said Herman Greenspun  
 a full and unconditional pardon.

and designated, directed and empowered the Attorney  
 General as his representative to sign this grant of Executive  
 Clemency.

In accordance with these instructions and authority I have  
 signed my name and caused the seal of the Department of  
 Justice to be affixed below and affirm that this action is the  
 act of the President being performed at his direction.

Done at the City of Washington this Eighteenth  
 day of October in the year of our Lord  
 One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-one  
 and of the Independence of the United States  
 the One Hundred and Eighty-fifth.
