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Police said to aid spying on political groups

Anti-Defamation League pays for info received from cops

A small group of undercover operatives throughout the nation is being paid by the Anti-Defamation League of the B'nai B'rith to spy on pro-Palestinian, black nationalist and white supremacist groups, according to a San Francisco law enforcement official.

The operatives rely on local police and sheriff's deputies to provide access to confidential law enforcement and motor vehicle information, in probable violation of criminal law, said the official, who spoke on condition of anonymity.

The official is close to the investigation of suspected illegal domestic spying by ex-San Francisco police Officer Tom Gerard and paid ADL informant Roy Bullock, a San Francisco art dealer.

"There's probably six or eight Roy Bullocks" throughout the country, the official said.

"This Gerard-Bullock thing is the tip of the iceberg — this is going on nationwide," another law enforcement official said.

Capt. John Willett of the Police Department's special investigations division said officers examining evidence in the case already had discovered files from up to 20 police departments and other law enforcement agencies throughout the state, including the California Department of Corrections and

Willett said information from Portland police and at least one other law enforcement agency outside California also had been found.

History of spying

The ADL acknowledges collecting and disseminating information on individuals and organizations, but claims such surveillance is legal and consistent with its mission: "to counteract all facets of bigotry and prejudice."

ADL attorney Barbara Wahl said Monday that the organization made "no bones" about getting information "from a variety of places, including individuals."

"If the implication is that there is anything improper about what ADL has done," Wahl said, referring to the Gerard-Bullock case, "we flatly deny that."

But ADL critics in the Arab American and Jewish American communities charge that — notwithstanding the organization's longtime record of opposition to patent bigotry — it has lost the ability to distinguish between justifiable and unjustifiable investigative techniques and targets.

monitor hate groups that make you cringe," said Boston lawyer Harvey Silverglade, a Jew who belongs to the civil rights panels of both the ADL and the American Civil Liberties Union. "And while they have the 'right' to infiltrate a pro-Palestinian group, it shows a lack of respect for freedom of assembly."

Was S.F. an ADL spy hub?

Gerard, 50, and Bullock, 58, are suspected of gathering confidential information from law enforcement sources illegally from 1985 to 1992. Bullock was paid by the ADL through an unidentified Los Angeles law firm. Neither man has been charged; both deny wrongdoing.

Gerard fled to the Philippines after questioning by the FBI. The United States and the Philippines

San Francisco District Attorney Arlo Smith said in an interview Friday that, whatever the scope of ADL information gathering proves to be, it was already evident that Gerard and Bullock monitored a wide range of groups from their base in San Francisco.

"This may well have been the center of it; it's clear Roy Bullock was serving the whole area," Smith said. He declined to elaborate.

Some 12,000 computerized files were seized Dec. 10 in searches of ADL offices in San Francisco and Los Angeles, Gerard's houseboat and storage locker in Sausalito and Bullock's Castro District apartment. Most of the material originated with Bullock, according to authorities.

The Los Angeles Times reported that half the names in evidence were those of Southern Californians, but San Francisco officials would not confirm that figure.

"The people live all over California and around the Western states; only a few hundred came from San Francisco," said Assistant District heading the investigation.

At least four were journalists. They worked for Mother Jones magazine, the Chronicle, the Los Angeles Times and the Philadelphia Inquirer.



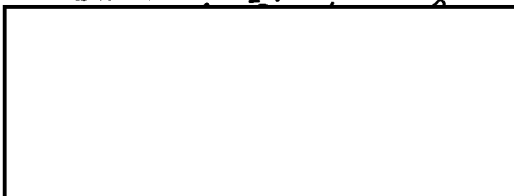



This sounds like the kind of thing that happens in a totalitarian police state.

The fact that the San Francisco investigation has already revealed that the ADL is conducting this operation on a national basis demands that a national Congressional inquiry be undertaken to get to the bottom of this scandal.

I am urging you to call for a full-dress Congressional inquiry into this scandal.

Please advise me as to what immediate action you will take to end this massive violation of American civil liberties.
