Dear Major Klimkowski:

We have activated our plans concerning our original project to conduct informational picketing at the location of the District Sales office of Japan Airlines in Miami. As I originally informed you our local activities are a part of a national campaign being conducted by the Anti-Defamation League, B'nai B'rith, and the Jewish War Veterans. Similar demonstrations have taken place in New York City and Philadelphia and following our activities here in Miami, informational picketing will take place in Atlanta and various cities on the west coast.

The details of our local activities are as follows:

1. Location - District Sales office of Japan Airlines, 200 S. E. 1st St., Miami.
2. The informational picketing will take place between the hours of 12 Noon and 1:30 P. M., January 8th, 9th, 10th, and 11th.
3. We plan to have approximately 30 individuals participate in these activities on each day. They will be instructed to be orderly and to keep the line continuously moving in order to avoid the blocking of pedestrians. We shall also instruct them to avoid blocking the entry of the premises of 200 S. E. 1st St.
4. The individuals participating in this picketing will be distributing hand-out literature by who question them concerning the reasons for the demonstration.
