No. 31-2004100 (iii) **Database Whith gampus Cognizations.** Some erganizations do not receive any funds which are to be expended solely for the purpose of attempting to influence builded. Both erganizations make such expenditures out of a general fund raised by dues, assessments, or other contributions. The permutage of the general fund which is used for such expenditures indicates the percentage of dues, assessments, or other contributions which may be considered to have been paid for that purpose. Therefore, in reporting receipts, such organizations may specify what that percentage is, and report their dues, assessments, and other contributions on that basis. However, each contributor of \$500 or more is to be listed, regardless of whether the contribution was made solely for legislative purposes.
