There are three main mission areas of activity of the Jewish agency, which are implemented primarily through the Immigration and Absorption Department, the Jewish Zionist Education Department and Israel Department, in coordination with Jewish Agency regions throughout the world.

**A) Immigration, Rescue and Initial Absorption**

The Jewish Agency provides six programmatic areas: rescue and aliyah operations, reaching out and assisting Jews in their aliyah, experiencing Israel for potential Olim, helping Olim with special needs, introducing Hebrew language, Israeli culture and Jewish heritage to support absorption and enhance Jewish identity, and empowering Olim.

**B) Jewish-Zionist Education and Identity**

The Jewish Agency works to meet the challenges in education and Jewish Identity by focusing on the following areas: creating a global human resource system, building an education bridge, and ensuring that the Jewish experience of Israel is at the core of developing Jewish Identity. In addition, the Jewish Agency provides educational services in the former Soviet Union and strengthens the sense of Jewish peoplehood among young Israelis.

**C) One People with Israel**

The Jewish Agency's challenge is to assure one, strong Jewish people in the future. To this end, the Jewish Agency is expanding its capacity to develop new partnerships, by creating new and innovative partnership models. In building such partnerships, which should place Israelis and world Jewry on an equal footing, the relevance of the partnership to both Israel and world Jewry should be taken into account.
