This organization, according to the preamble to its constitution, exists in order to promote Elemist activities in the United States, and to further the sim and purpose of the Basis Flatforn, namely, to establish a publicly recognized and legally secured home for the Jewish people in Palestine. 18 On September 6, 1938 the Department of State, at that time the administrative agency of the Foreign Agents Registration Act, sent the organization a copy of the Rules and Regulations of the Act and requested a detailed statement of facts regarding the organization's activities as agent of a foreign principal. The Zionist Organisation of America on September 9, 1935 replied in a letter stating that in the opinion of the Organization's counsel it was not an organization whose registration was contemplated by the Act. The letter contained a statement of facts, pointing out that the work of the Organization has a two-fold purpose: (1) to explain Zionism to American Jows, and (2) to win friendly cooperation and public opinion for Monism. The second is done in collaboration with the Keren Hayasod (Palastine Foundation Fund) and the Keren Kayeneth (Jewish National Fund of America, Inc.). It was stated that similar Zionist groups exist in other countries and all are represented by a Norld Zionist Congress, with headquarters apparently in Jerusales, which meets bi-annually and is composed of delegates from the various Zionist groups. The World Zionist Congress was said to be "the suprems moral body of the Zionist movement in the same that its decisions as to policies and fund-raising are to guide the various groups participating in the work of the Zionist movement." It was further stated that the American Monist group does not receive Amds from the World Zionist Congress but that, on the contrary, every number of the American Organisation pays an annual due of \$.50 (the Shekel) for the purpose of participating in the election of delegates to the Zionist World Congress. There also exists the Jowish Agency for Palestine, recognised in the Mandate of the Longue of Mations, a body composed of representative Sionists and Jewish

hom-Zionists for the purpose of devising and cooperating with the Administration of Palestins. The Zionist Organization of America through the Palestine Foundation Fund assists collection of money needed by the Agency for its programs. The State Department, in a letter dated September 15, 1938, stated that "on the sole basis of the information set forth in your letter it would appear that you are correct in your understanding that the activities of the Zionist Organization of america do not fall within the purview of the provisions of the act mentioned."

A Department of State menorandum dated August 11, 1941 in interpreting the Foreign Agents Registration act of 1936, as assended, stated that the Michael Organization of America as an affiliate of the World Michael Congress, which determines and directs the policies of its member organizations, is subject to registration. A conference between Mr. E. A. Schulson, Assistant to the Executive Director of the Organization and a representative of the Department of State, was reported in a memorandum dated August 20, 1941. In that conference the agency relationship with the World Michael Congress was again denied. A letter of October 8, 1941 from the Organization to the State Department denied in writing the agency relationship and expressed the opinion that the Organization was not subject to registration under the Act. This letter was later acknowledged.

The State Department file in this matter contains copies of the latters and semorands from which I have quoted above along with various pumphlate and literature and copies of the constitutions of the American Mionist Organisation and the Norld Mionist Congress. It is edmitted that the American Organization is an affiliate of the Borld Zionist Congress. As an affiliate of the World Zionist Congress the Organisation is subject to the provisions of the Constitution of the Borld Zionist Congress. Article 79 of the Congress Constitution indicates that an element of control exists imagement as political negotiations with governments and the Langue of Mations may be conducted by Zionist groups only with the approval of the Executive Congress. The article further states that the adhesion of bodies to the Michist Organisation presupposes that in all Monist questions the duty of discipling in regard to the Zionist Organisation (apparently meaning the Congress) must take precedence over the duty of discipline in regard to may other organization. Disciplinary measures against member groups are provided in the article.

To sugmarize, the World Zionist Congress directs the policies of the American Zionist Organisation as one of its affiliates and by its Constitution exercises some degree of control over certain of the
