## Mr. Prices

Mr. H. A. Schulson, assistant to Mr. Isidor Breslau, Executive Director of the Zionist Organisation of America, called at the office this afternoon in response to the Department's letter of July 28, 1941 in which the possible obligations of the Zionist Organisation in America under the Act of June 8, 1938, as amended, requiring the registration of agents of fereign principals, were again brought to the attention of that organisation.

Mr. Schulson stated that although the Zionist Organisation of America considered itself an affiliate of the
Congress of the World Zionist Organisation, it was in no
way under the direction of that Congress. He stated that
although the Zionist organisations in the various countries were all working for the establishment of a national
home for the Jewish people in Palestine, these national
groups were in no way under the direction of the world
organization. In fact, he said, it was well known that

the Lichtst organisation in this country contestbuted large sums to the veric organization. In Schulson a stated that his organisation would be portestly willing to extent a Registration Statement if that were required, but he said that the officers of the organisation were shoroughly convinced that no agency relationship existed in their affiliation with the world Elouist organization. He stated that a number of the officers of the organisation would be glad to some in and discuss further the possible obligations of the Elemist Organization of America if that would help clear up the situation. He showed me the draft of a latter that had been prepared in reply to the Department's letter of July 26 stating substantially what he had told me. I suggested that he submit this letter to the Department which he said he would do. He left a copy of the constitution of the Liquist Organisation of America for the files of the Department,
